The event was enabled by Lesy České republiky, s. p.

Date: June 25–26, 2022

Event Centre: Jestřebí, 50°36'27.005"N, 14°34'37.297"E, next to the road No. 9, on the old road

towards the bust stop Jestřebí. Will be marked with an orienteering flag.

Programme: Sat June 25 Relay (Czech Championships and public race)

Classic (Pre-O) course (WRE/ECTO and public race)

Sun June 26 TempO (WRE/ECTO)

Terrain: Sandstone valleys. Roads with a firm surface, own pushers at own consideration. All

competitors are kindly requested to offer help to wheelchair users outside measured

competition parts.

Entries: In-situ entries according to the organiser's capacity.

Entry Fees: 20 EUR (500 CZK) for each WRE/ECTO competition and a relay team entry,

classic course public race free of charge.

Entry fee is to be paid at the registration unless paid beforehand by a bank transfer. Please have the exact amount ready, especially when paying with Euros.

Registration: On Saturday at the Competition Centre of the Relay competition in Sosnová,

9:00–11:00. [Changed since the invitation!]

12:30–15:00 in the Event Centre in Jestřebí. A representative of each club/team receives

chip sets and number bibs for the whole team.

Start numbers for the relay race are different from the individual race numbers.

During races, the bib must be worn visibly.

Special symbol: green cross – root stock.

Rules: IOF rules

Punching: ToePunch system (we recommend reading the instructions on toe.yq.cz). Every

competitor has the same set of chips for both Saturday races. The chip sets will be handed out at registration and handed back at the readout of the last race (on Saturday). No chips are needed on Sunday, Timed controls and TempO stations are measured by

ANT.

Results: On the web <u>top.yq.cz</u>.

Complaints and Complaints should be made in writing to any of the event officials.

Protests: Protests should be made in writing to the Main referee, the fee is 10 EUR

(250 CZK). The time limits are given below for each race.

Jury: Dušan Furucz (SVK), John Kewley (GBR), Pavel Ptáček (CZE).

Changing, washing: Not provided by the organisers.

Prize giving: Each race separately, the first three places in each category and the first three places

in the Czech Championships will be awarded. The ceremony will be held on Sunday, immediately after the TempO race finish, estimated at 14:00. Every participant of the

open public race will receive a diploma at its finish.


Relay, Sat Jun 25 morning

Competition: Czech Championships, public race

Competition Centre:

Sosnová, 50°39'26.824"N, 14°32'9.956"E, no shelter.

Route will be marked from the cross of road No. 9, exit Sosnová, road No. 00913. Exit towards Okřešice (right when coming from Mělník, left from Česká Lípa) is embargoed!



Classes: Elite

Course: 3 x 8 controls + 3 x 1 TempO cluster, length 3 x 130 m, no elevation, free-order punching.

Only A–Z controls with no decision points. There are several courses in the forest,

therefore there are more flags than tasks for each leg.

Time limit is 85 min plus 5 min for each P class member of the team.

Competition Area:

The competition area of this race will be excluded from the embargo for the WTOC after

the finish of the race.

Maps: Maps for the classical part are printed on a synthetic paper PRETEX of A5 format.

Maps will be collected by the chip read-out.

Zero tolerance: 4 m, no exceptions.

Punching:

ToePunch system. Each team member has her/his own set of ToePunch chips. The competitors have to clear all chips of the set at the CLEAR station in the start area. Start time is recorded by punching the START station and finish time by the FINISH station. After returning to the Competition Centre, the competitor downloads the ToePunch data at the readout, and the punching record is printed. The record is kept by the referee until the start of the last competitor. In case of the ToePunch malfunction, the competitors punch a classic paper card with their own needle punches, safety pin, or anything suitable. **The competitor must inform the readout referee about the used back-up punching.**

TempO cluster is measured with ANT by two referees.

Registration:

In the Competition Centre in Sosnová, 9:00–11:30 [Change since the Invitation!]. A representative of each club/team receives chip sets and number bibs for the whole team. Please have the exact amount ready in case of cash payment of the entry fee, especially when paying with Euros.

Parking:

Parking for wheelchair users is in the Competition Centre, east of Road No. 9. It is necessary to arrive via Sosnová from the west through an underpass, see the plan. Parking for other competitors is possible at parking places in the village, or along the street (the green line). Heed all the road rules! The only possible access to the Competition Centre is from the west through the underpass.

Start:

Czech Championships: 9:30, mass start

Public race: 11:00–12:00, start lists are published at the event web page.

Change-over:

Neither Start, nor Finish are in the Competition Centre. First leg competitors should leave the Competition Centre approximately 10 mins ahead of their start time. Starting referee allows the competitors to start by punching the START ToePunch station. When a competitor finishes her/his leg, a referee sends a signal to the Competition Centre for the next leg of the relay to move to start. On their way back to the centre, the competitors shall not needlessly stay in the competition area and communicate with other competitors. The change-over is done at the start point by touching hands. The competitors can hand over their **stopwatch and backup paper punching card. The relay members need to watch their time by themselves!** After the hand-over, the next leg competitor punches the START station and starts the race. The previous leg competitor proceeds to the TempO station and to the Competition Centre.

Complaints and Protests:

Competition maps, punch records and solutions will be handed out after the start of all last leg competitors, cca 13:30 in the Event Centre (Jestřebí). Complaints shall be made before 16:30.

Distances:

event centre – parking 9 km
parking – competition centre 100 m – 1 km
competition centre – change-over 200 m

WC:

Disabled mobile WC will be available in the competition centre and in the event centre.

Refreshment:

Public food places in Sosnová, Jestřebí and surrounding.


Classic Course (PreO), Sat Jun 25 afternoon



Competitions: Czech Trail-O Championships, WRE, European Cup in Trail-O, Czech PRE-O Cup

Competition centre:

Event centre, Jestřebí, 50°36'27.005"N, 14°34'37.297"E, no shelter.



Classes: Elite Open, Elite Physically Challenged, Elite Junior (born 1. 1. 2002 or later)

Course: 30 controls in two parts (9+21) + 2 TC clusters at the beginning of the course, free-order

punching. Course length 400 m (150+250), elevation +10/-20 m, distance between the two parts cca 500 m +15/-15m. Time limit is 102 min/120 min for Elite P. A–Z controls have

decision points.

Competition Area:

This area will be excluded from the embargo for the WTOC after the end of the Sunday

race.

Maps: Maps for the first part are printed on a synthetic paper PRETEX of A5 format, maps for the

second part on the A4 format.

Maps will be collected at the finish of each part.

Zero tolerance: 4 m, or 8 m when the distance is over 100 m, no exceptions.

Punching: ToePunch system. Each team member has her/his own set of ToePunch chips (the same as

for the relays). The competitors have to clear all chips of the set at the CLEAR station in the start area. Each part of the race is started by punching the START station and finished by punching the FINISH station. After returning to the Competition Centre, the competitor downloads the ToePunch data at the readout, and the punching record is printed. The record is kept by the referee until the start of the last competitor. In case of the ToePunch

TempO clusters are measured with ANT by two referees.

Registration: In the Competition Centre from 12:30 to 15:00, for the competitors who have not

participated in the relay race, a representative of each club/team receives chip sets and number bibs. Please have the exact amount ready in case of cash payment of the

starting fee, especially when paying with Euros.

Parking: On the old road No. 9 between the Competition Centre and the bus stop Jestřebí. **Please**

leave the slots close to the Competition Centre free for wheelchair users.

Start: 12:30 – 16:30, startlists are published at the competition web page.

The competitors need to walk approximately 80 metres along the busy road No. 9 to access

the first time control from the pre-start. A marshal will control entry to this part.

Complaints and

Protests:

Competition maps, punch records and solutions will be handed out after the start of all

competitors. Complaints should be made not later than 30 minutes after announcing the

final results.

Distances: parking – competition centre, pre-start 0–200 m

finish – competition centre 1,3 km + 20 m elevation

WC: Disabled mobile WC will be available in the competition centre.

Refreshment: Public food places in Sosnová, Jestřebí and surrounding.

Competitions: Czech Trail-O Championships, WRE, European Cup in Trail-O, Czech PRE-O Cup

Comp. Centre: Event centre, Jestřebí, 50°36'27.005"N, 14°34'37.297"E

Classes: E Open, E Junior

Course: 6 clusters with 5 tasks, 600 m, elevation gain 0 m

Competition Area: See embargoed area #5 of the WTOC 2023

This area will be excluded from the embargo for the WTOC after the end of this race.

Zero tolerance: 4 m, or 8 m when the distance is over 100 m, no exceptions.

Punching: Measured with ANT by two referees. The referees write the result to the competitor's card.

The cards are collected at the last station and handed back together with solution maps

after the start of the last competitor.

Registration: Individually in the Competition Centre for competitors who have not registered

themselves on Saturday.

Parking: On the old road No. 9 between the Competition Centre and the bus stop Jestřebí. Please

leave the slots close to the Competition Centre free for wheelchair users.

Start: 9:00–13:00, startlists published at the event web page.

The competitors need to walk approximately 80 metres along the busy road No. 9 on the

way to the start. A marshal will control entry to this part.

Distances: parking – competition centre 0–200 m

competition centre – start 1,3 km + 10 m elevation finish – competition centre 1,9 km + 30 m elevation

WC: Disabled mobile WC will be available in the competition centre.

Refreshment: Public food places in Sosnová, Jestřebí and surrounding.



Public race (classic course), Sat Jun 25 afternoon

Competitions: Multiplier sport event of the ORIENT project.

Comp. Centre: Event centre, Jestřebí, 50°36'27.005"N, 14°34'37.297"E, no shelter.

Classes: A O (open), A P (physically challenged)

Course: 9 controls + 2 TC clusters at the beginning, length 150 m, elevation +10 m,

Z answers are possible.

Entries: In-situ entries according to the organiser's capacity.

Entry fees: Free

Zero tolerance: Should the answer be Zero, no control can be closer than 4 metres to the right place.

Punching: ToePunch system. Each team member has her/his own set of ToePunch chips. The

competitors have to clear all chips of the set at the CLEAR station in the start area. Start time is recorded by punching the START station and finish time by the FINISH station. After returning to the Competition Centre, the competitor downloads the ToePunch data at the readout, and the punching record is printed. The record is kept by the referee until the start of the last competitor. In case of the ToePunch malfunction, the competitors punch a classic paper card with their own needle punches, safety pin, or anything suitable. The competitor must inform the readout referee about the used back-up punching.

TempO cluster is measured with ANT by two referees.

Parking: On the old road No. 9 between the Competition Centre and the bus stop Jestřebí. **Please**

leave the slots close to the Competition Centre free for wheelchair users.

Registration: In the event centre on Saturday 11:30–15:00. The competitors will receive number

bibs and a set of chips.

Start: 12:00–15:00

The competitors need to walk approximately 80 metres along the busy road No. 9 to access

the first time control from the pre-start. A marshal will control entry to this part.

Distances: parking – competition centre, pre-start 0–200 m

finish – competition centre 600 m

WC: Disabled mobile WC will be available in the competition centre.

Refreshment: Public food places in Sosnová, Jestřebí and surrounding.

Awards: Every competitor received a diploma immediately after finishing the race by the

chip readout.
